**Texas SmartScape® (North Central Texas Region) Plant Photos**

Photos for the following North Central Texas region plants are needed (see the table below). The best photos will be chosen and posted as part of the “Search Plant Database.” Appropriate credit will be given.

**Requirements:**

Please submit two photos per plant and email them to Erin Blackman at [eblackman@nctcog.org](mailto:eblackman@nctcog.org). Send no more than two photos per email.

The following jpeg size and formats are preferred:

- Small dimension (192 x 128) at a resolution of 72 pixels per inch
- Large dimension (768 x 512) at a resolution of 72 pixels per inch

The small dimension photo is to be displayed on the plant’s information page. This photo should be a picture of the entire plant. The large dimension photo is to be displayed for more plant detail, and should be a close-up of the plant to focus on the plant’s leaves, flowers, etc.

Send only pictures you have taken; DO NOT send copyrighted pictures or pictures obtained from a web site or other source. In the body of your email, please indicate your name and organization, if applicable, for crediting purposes as well as a statement releasing your photo to the North Central Texas Council of Governments’ for use on the SmartScape site and other purposes, as needed.
